Fix It — Oops ... made a mistake!!

How many rows have to be ripped?? Learn some fix-it techniques that may keep you from the dreaded ripping. Fix a slipped stitch, a twisted stitch, or a stitch that should have been a knit/purl and is the opposite. Slip a pattern (several stitches) down and re-knit without the mistake. If ripping is necessary, learn to take the needle out of the work, rip the knitting down and then replace the needle. Learn the use of a "life line".

Sweater sleeves/body too short or too long? Learn to cut a thread and remove the knitting below; then, pick up the live stitches and knit down. Honest you cannot tell the difference.
