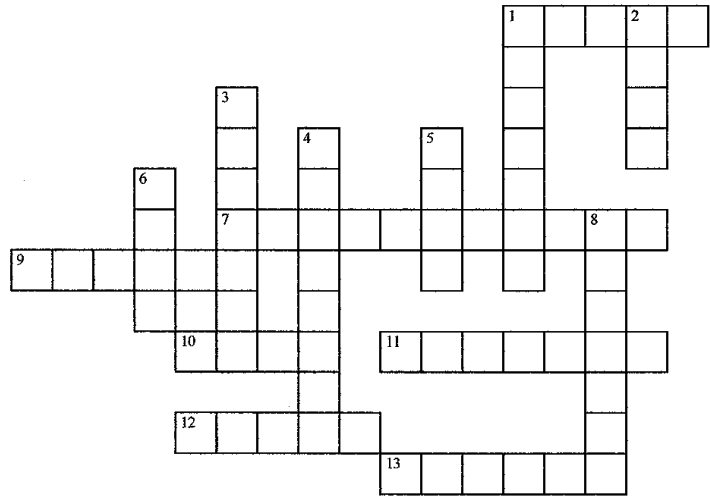
Store credit given with cancellation 7 days prior to start of class.

DOWN

- 1 To make a piece of needlework by looping thread with a hooked needle
- 2 A delicate fabric made of yarn or thread in an open weblike pattern
- 3 A tightly twisted woolen yarn spun from long-staple wool
- 4 A method of stretching and shaping a finished knitted piece to reach the dimensions suggested in the pattern, to make two pieces that need to match the same size, or to make your stitches look nicer and more even
- 5 To make (a garment, fabric, etc.) by interlocking loops of one or more yarns either by hand with knitting needles or by machine
- 6 Noro _____ Garden
- 8 Tightness of worked stitches

ACROSS

- 1 A stitch, which looks like a twisted rope and is both decorative and practical
- 7 A knitting pattern made by alternating single rows of knit stitches and of purl stitches



ACROSS

- 9 A number printed on the paper band surrounding the ball of yarn which is used to identify that batch of yarn color
- 10 _____turbo needles
- 11 Novelty yarn
- 12 A test piece which is knit before starting the project
- 13 A sleeve that extends in one piece to the neckline of the garment, with slanted seams from the armhole to the neck
